Founded in 1955, the society has maintained regional awareness of the natural resource of the night sky. In 1966 the society began building an observatory in Lewisberry, PA. The Society meetings are the second Monday of every month. Meetings start at 7:30pm and are held at the observatory during the summer months, May through September. During the Months of October through April, the society meets at a Harrisburg Area Community College. The meetings consist of a business portion followed by a program on astronomical subjects.

The observatory is open to the public every Sunday night during the summer months and selected dates throughout the year. Members of the society will be on hand to introduce people to the wonders of astronomy. We welcome groups at anytime, by arrangement.

The society has four large research grade telescopes. A 17 inch Classical Cassegrain telescope is located in the main dome observatory. The roll-off roof building contains a 12.5 inch Cave Newtonian telescope. In the newest building is a pair of 14 inch Schmidt-Cassegrain telescopes, one of which is dedicated to CCD Photography.

Other scopes include: 10 inch Cave Newtonian, 8 inch Schmidt-Cassegrain, 6 inch Newtonian, and a solar (heliostat) telescope. Other, smaller telescopes are available to members on a loan basis. The main administration building contains a classroom, kitchen, and lavatory. Membership is made up of people from all walks of life who share a common interest in astronomy and related sciences. New members benefit from the shared knowledge of more experienced members.

DIRECTIONS TO THE NAYLOR OBSERVATORY: (670 Observatory Drive, Lewisberry, PA 17339)

- ▶ **FROM HARRISBURG:** Take I-83 South to Exit 39A. Route 114 toward Lisburn until Route 382. Follow Route 382 for 2 miles. Turn right onto School House Lane. Follow School House Lane to Brenneman Drive. Turn right onto Brenneman drive and follow it to Observatory Drive on the left. Take Obervatory and go approximately 1000 feet to the observatory entrance on the left.
- ▶ **FROM YORK:** Take I-83 North to Exit 32. Take Route 382 to Lewisberry and thru the flashing lights at Route 177. Continue on Route 382 for a mile. Turn left onto Brenneman Drive. Turn Left onto Observatory Drive. Go 1000-feet to the observatory entrance on the left.
- ▶ **FROM US 15:** Take Route 114 through Lisburn. Turn right onto Moore's Mountain Road (immediately across the bridge). Go 8/10 of a mile and turn left onto Brenneman Road. Turn right onto Observatory Drive. Go 1000-feet of the observatory entrance on the left.
